## ARTIST SUBMISSION APPLICATION

Endangered Planet invites submission of your application and artwork images for review. Any artist supporting our mission working in any medium is invited to apply. The goal of the Endangered Planet Gallery (EPG) is to raise awareness by creating and promoting an online collection of artwork for environmental minded collectors to peruse and purchase, and also to create a curatorial collection from which the gallery can select artists for potential exhibition at Endangered Planet Gallery.

#### Accepted artist is required to:

1. have an inventory of 3 - 30 works made available for sale through the galley online.
2. have a non-exclusive one year membership with annual renewal by mutual agreement.
3. submit the completed and signed application form.

#### Submission Policy

The Endangered Planet Gallery artists are a carefully selected group of diverse and talented American and International artists whose works form a significant part of the gallery's collection and inventory. All artists must support the Endangered Planet mission to exhibit at the gallery or on-line. Artists selected to exhibit at the gallery will have images of their work placed on the gallery's website and made available for online purchase. Artwork is also promoted to consultants, collectors and potential clients. Artists not exhibited are also selected to be on-line and become part of the global network of Endangered Planet Artist Members. Along with our exhibited artists, all member artists also become part of our curatorial pool and are considered for exhibition.

As of July 1, 2007, we are currently accepting submissions from artists who would like to be considered for inclusion in our expanding on-line gallery. All accepted Endangered Planet artists must have an inventory of three to twenty-five works available for sale through the galley's online shopping cart system

#### Guidelines

To be considered, please complete fully and send the following:

1. **A signed application form.** Print out pdf form and Fax form to: 949.497.6106
2. **Three to five images** of your work. Email your jpg files to: [info@endangeredplanet.net](mailto:info@endangeredplanet.net)  
Files are to be RGB and smaller than 1 meg each. Larger files will be rejected. When sending jpg files, please name your digital files in the following format (abbreviate name if possible, provide retail price, also list these titles in your email)

3. **A \$45 application fee** (non-refundable). Note: This fee only covers submission of up to five images for our review. Additional images included in submission are \$10 each, with a maximum of thirty. Fee paid does not constitute acceptance to the gallery.

Artist agent or representative may apply in behalf of the artist. Artist must also sign the agreement.

Please do not send us items in the mail unless the application fee is paid.

### Acceptance

If accepted, your \$45 application fee can be applied to the on-line marketing package of your choice. If you are accepted, all additional submitted images are individually accepted or rejected based on our mission and the intrinsic contribution to the Endangered Planet global member network. Endangered Planet Gallery requires a non-exclusive one year commitment with annual renewal by mutual agreement. See agreement details.

### Part IV – Additional information

- Artists selected for exhibition in the gallery will pay for shipping, including return costs.
- Artist must insure their work for loss or damage during shipping. Art is insured while at EPG.
- All artwork must be for sale and owned by you.
- The gallery receives a 50% commission on gallery sales.
- The gallery pays artist in US\$ within 30 days of completed sales to address in Part I.
- If an exhibition - exhibited work must arrive as scheduled and ready for installation.
- EPG has an application fee of \$45 for three to five submitted images, with \$10 for each additional image, up to a maximum of 30. If accepted into the Endangered Planet Gallery Member network, these fees cover membership for one year and the submitted images become part of the artist's inventory which we promote to consultants, collectors and clients.
- At the end of the first year, artist may choose to renew their membership at the prevailing rate, thus remaining in the curatorial pool and keeping their artwork in the gallery collection for sale (current annual member renewal rate is \$45 for 3 images, plus \$5 for each additional).
